Marianthe Stavridou is working on an independent Expert Paper Review named : "*The impact of Artificial Intelligence on our Societies*" funded by the European Commission's Directorate General *Research and Innovation*. The paper will inform the future HORIZON Research funding and further policy on the matter. Expected results: End of March 2025  
Furthermore, Marianthe evaluated (January 2025) eleven Marie Curie Research Projects and participated in the evaluation of seven Horizon Research projects (June 2024)

Members of the ISOC-CH engaged with ISOC global through regular Advisory meetings with Nick Hyrka and the ISOC European Regional calls, in one of which the NGI0 programme was introduced.

## Project Activities

The engagement of ISOC-CH with the NGIO Commons Fund started, and a first hybrid information event was organized at L200:

Hernani Marques was hired with a 30% contract to develop a specialized tech dossier on AI and free software targeted for educators of school teachers with a specific case study in Switzerland as an example.

Engagement with the Global Encryption Coalition

**ISOC CH** co-signed the following joint letters

- [Letter to the EU Council](#) urging them to reject all scanning proposals that are inconsistent with the principles of end-to-end encryption.
- [Letter to the UK Secretary](#) opposing the UK Home Office's demand that Apple create a backdoor into its end-to-end encrypted services, an unprecedented move against user privacy ([WP](#), [BBC](#)). This letter highlights the risks this demand poses to security, privacy, economy, and freedom of expression. As a result, Apple [removed its Advanced Data Protection feature for new users in the UK](#).

Discussions are ongoing on the following topic:

- **E2EE & AI Assistants** - A new paper analyzes AI assistants' compatibility with end-to-end encryption (E2EE) Read here: <https://eprint.iacr.org/2024/2086.pdf>. Key takeaways: AI should **not** be trained on E2EE content; processing should be local; for true **end-to-end privacy and integrity**, AI must not bypass encryption, and consent should be **opt-in, off by default**.
