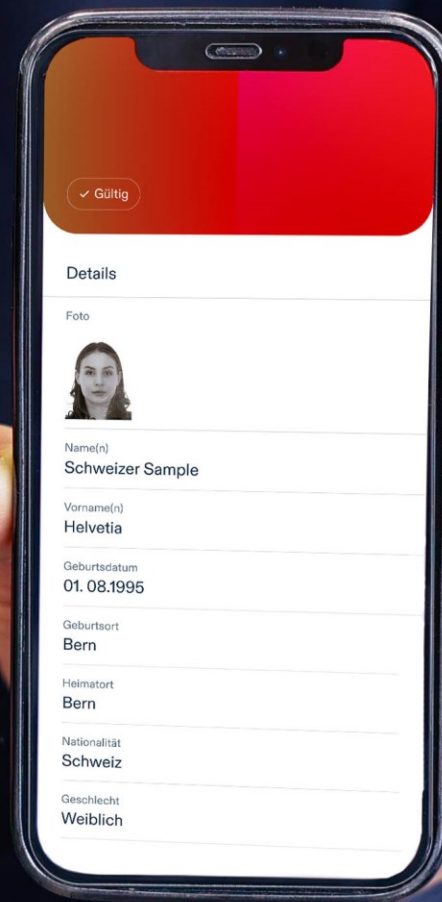

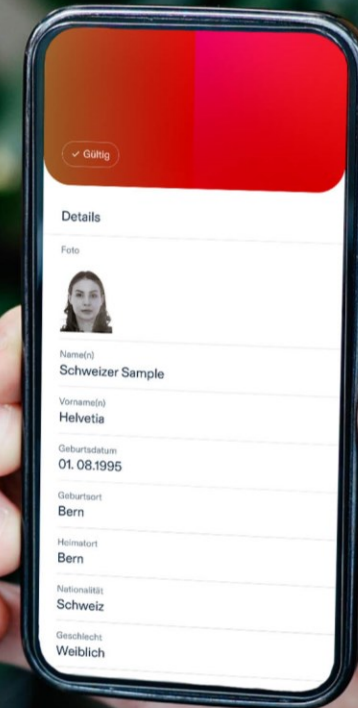
On the internet, nobody knows who I really am

No more interruption in data flows

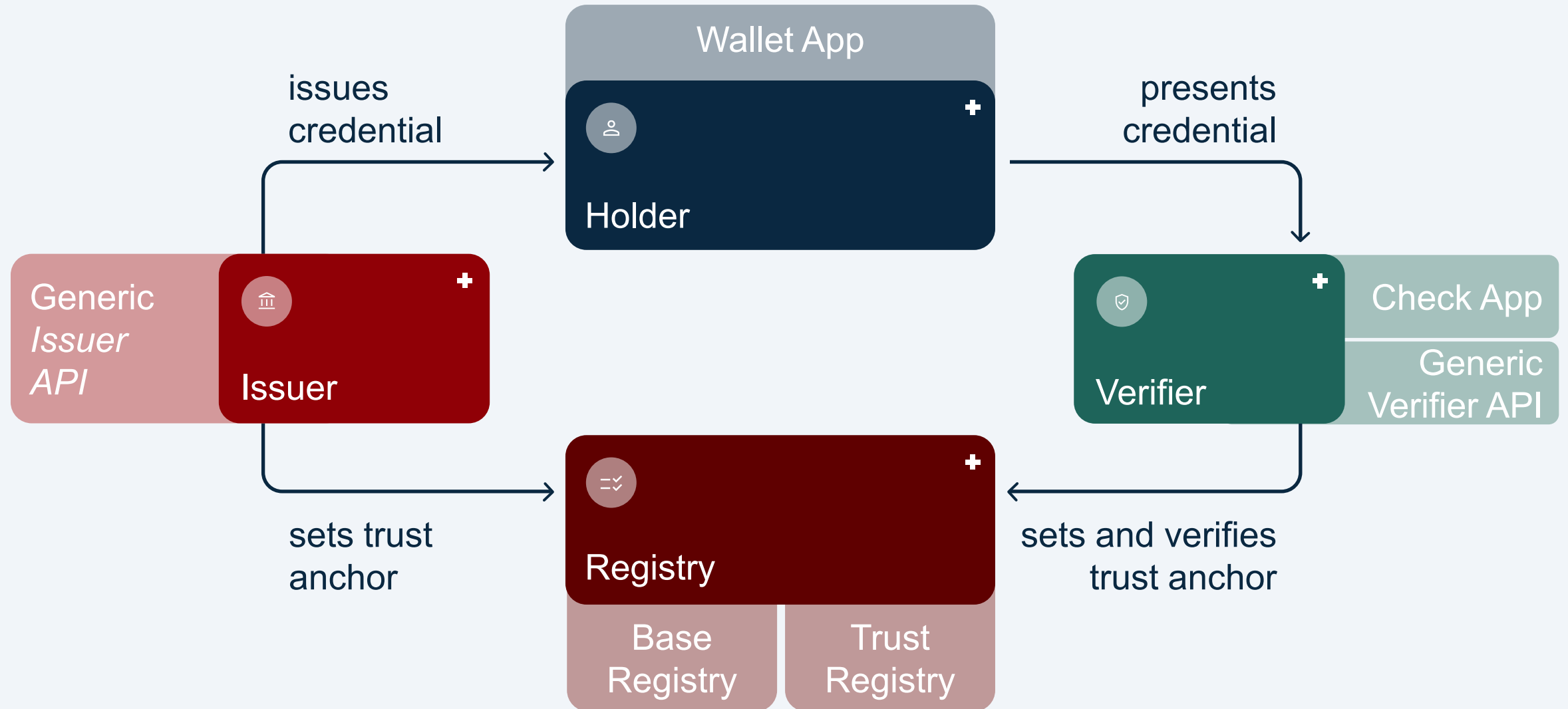



With the e-ID, I control

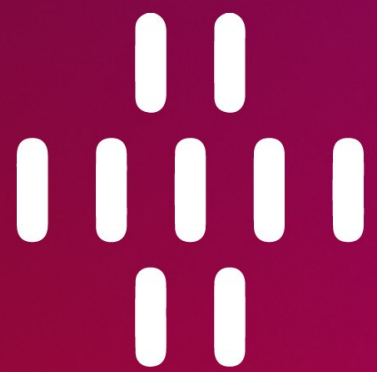

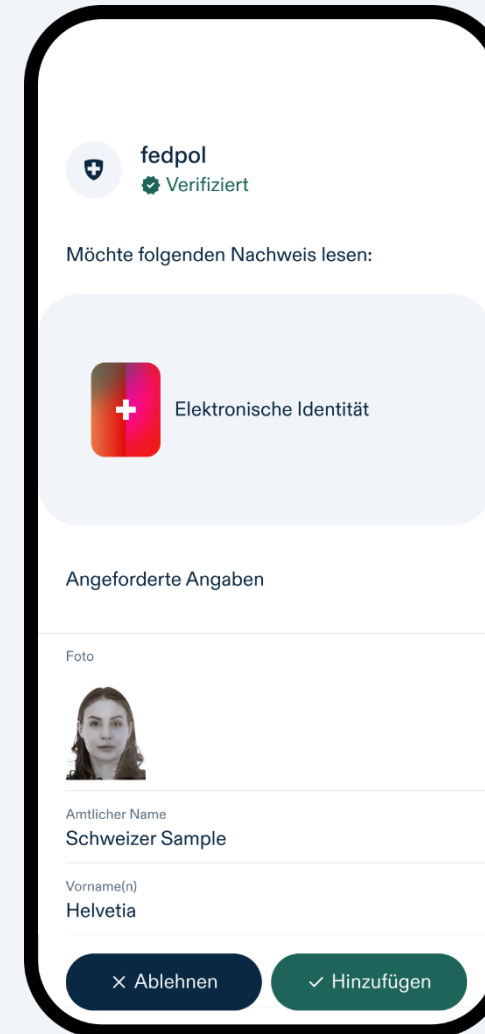

How is my e-ID secured,
and my privacy
protected?

This is how my e-ID is issued

- fedpol verifies the applicant's identity using existing registry data
- The e-ID will only be issued if it can be bound to the owner – or rather, to the owner's device (use of a cryptoprocessor)
- There are no different trust levels of the e-ID. Online and on-site issuance are equivalent



This is how my e-ID is secured

- e-ID is only stored on my smartphone (decentralised data storage)
- e-ID is linked to my smartphone (device binding)
- e-ID is only valid from my smartphone (no replay)
- Transparency (open-source software)
- External controls (pen tests, bug bounties)
- Continuous further development



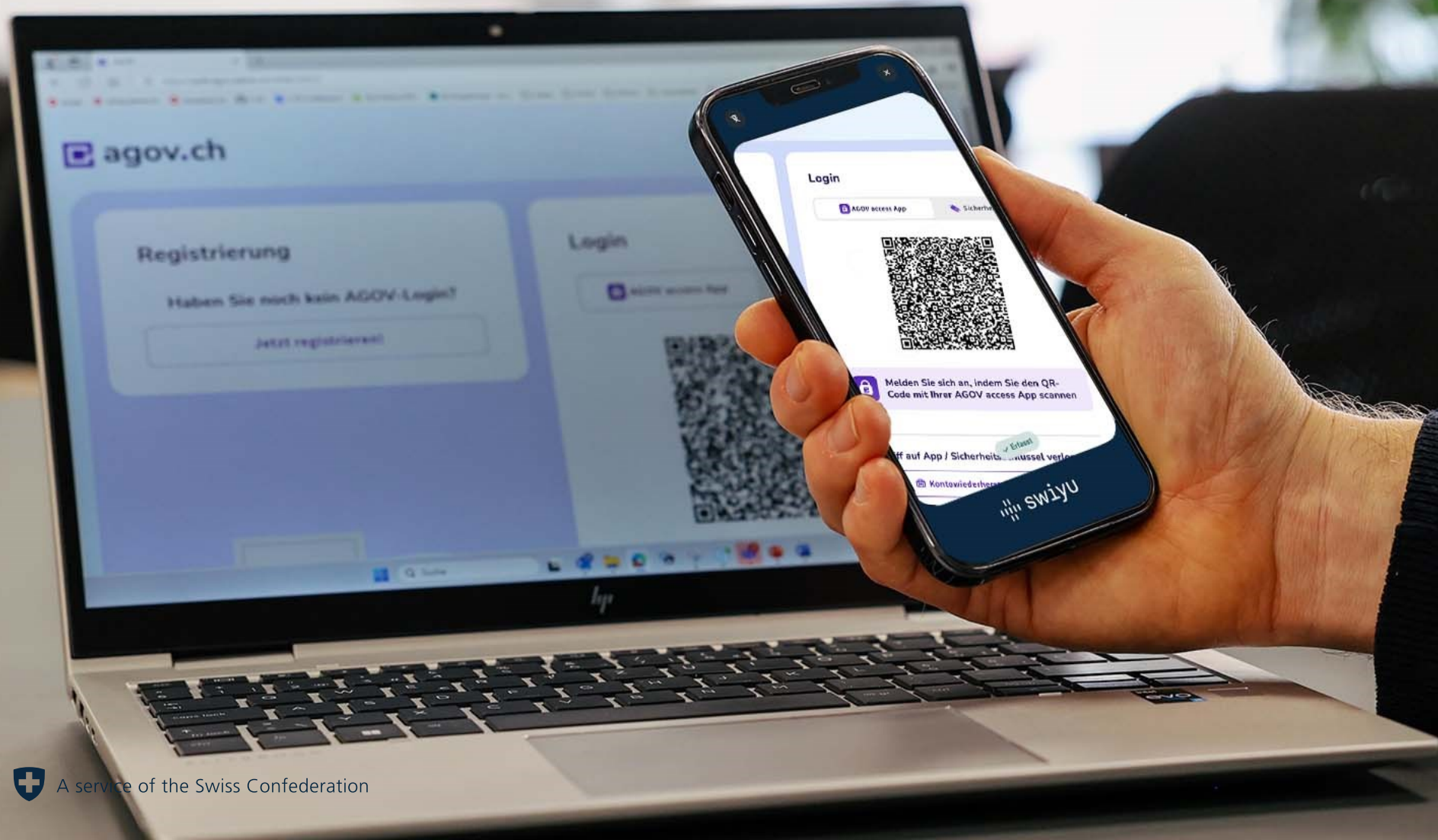
This is how my privacy is protected

- I always know who I am dealing with (basic and trust register)
- I decide whether to show my data
- Less data is more (data minimisation)
- No profiling (unlinkability of the e-ID)
- Securing of issuing data in federal government data centres in Switzerland

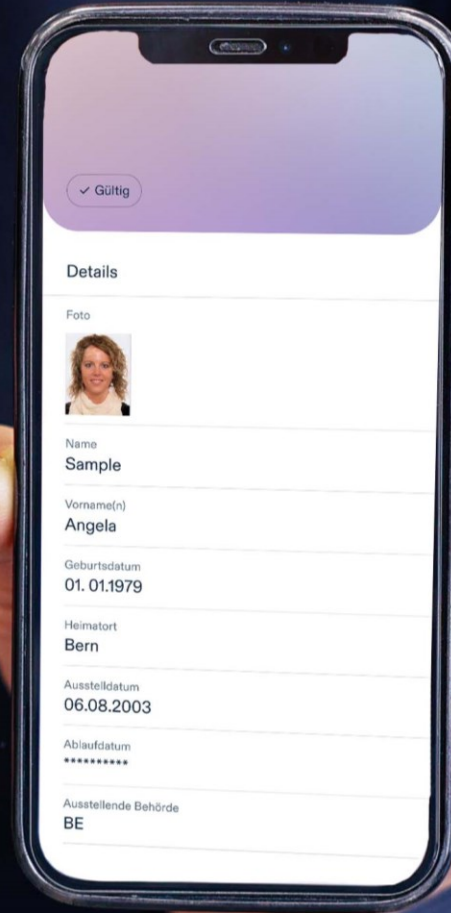

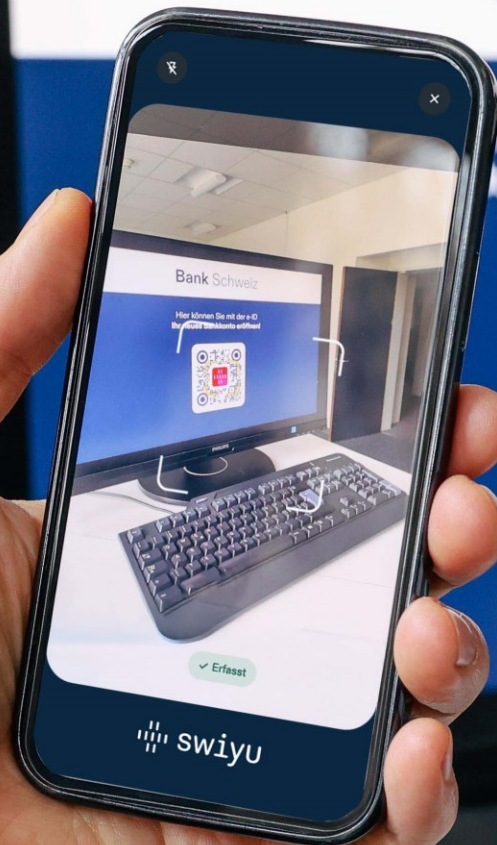

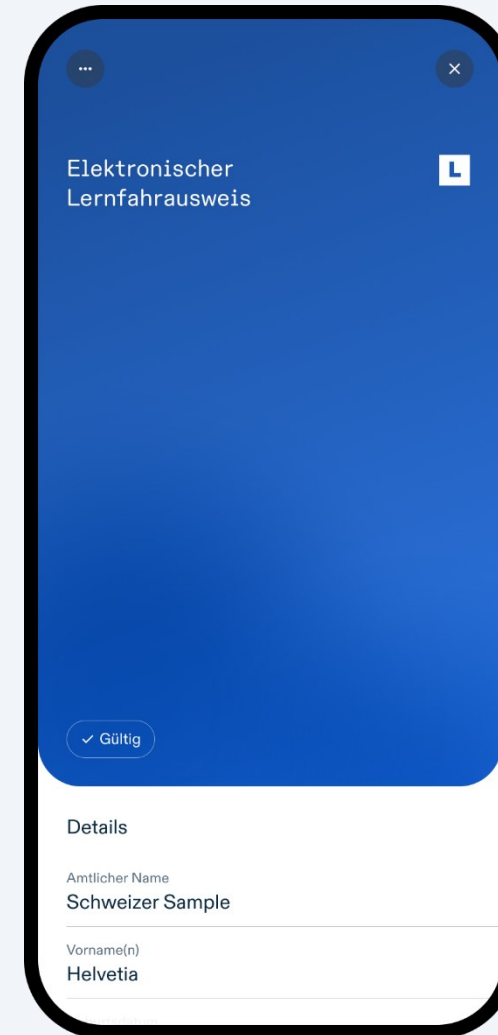

ePDL is already a reality

- The pilot phase of the electronic learning licence has been running in the canton of Appenzell-Ausserrhoden since spring 2024.
- Approximately 1200 people already use the electronic learning license.
- The pilot phase will be rolled out throughout Switzerland from early summer 2025.

Interoperability of the e-ID

- Initially, the e-ID will not yet be recognised abroad. However, recognition is a medium-term goal
- Switzerland is co-chair of the Governmental Consultative Committee of the Open Wallet Forum of the International Telecommunication Union
- An international conference on interoperability will take place in Geneva in July 2025

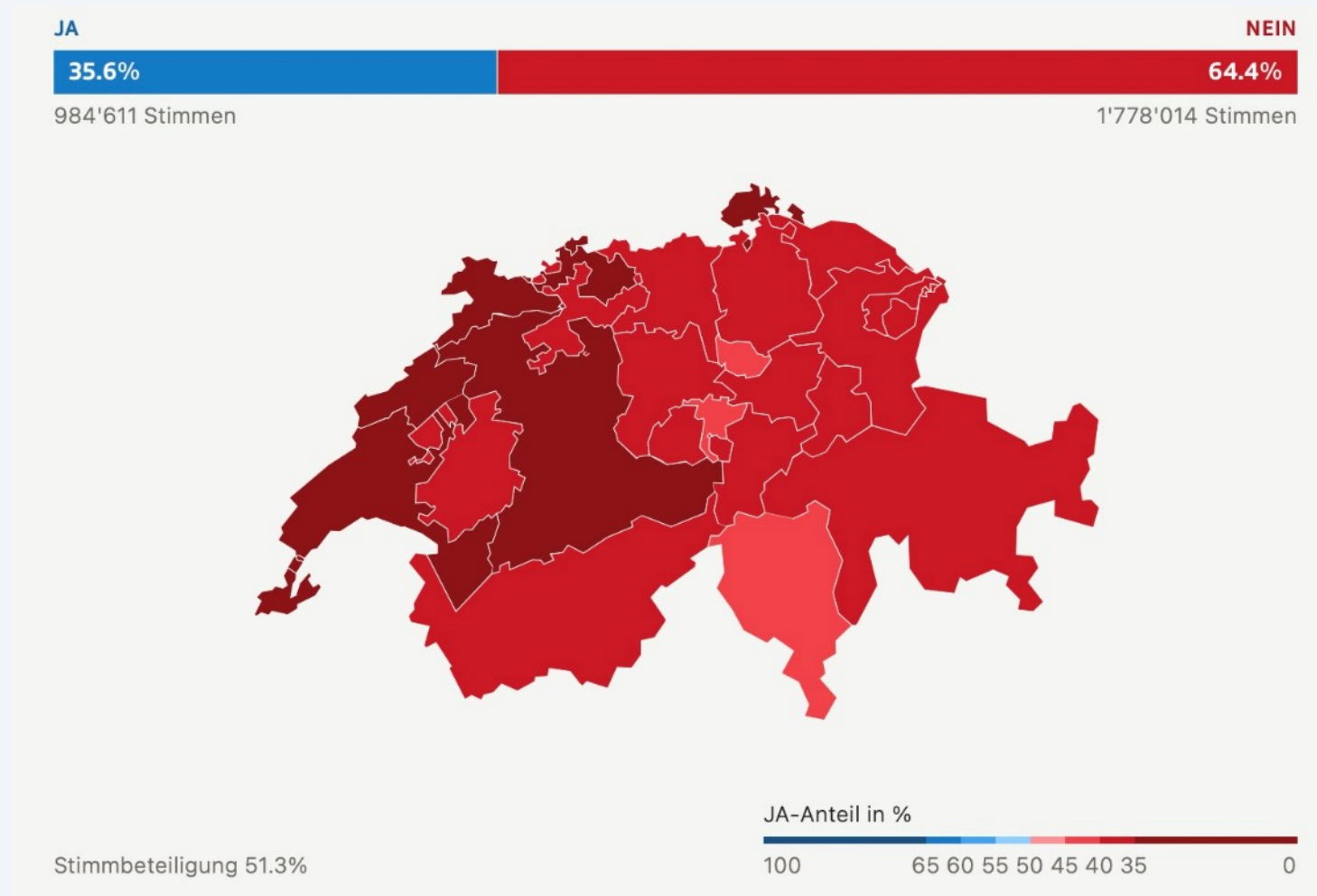

Contents of the e-ID

Attributes relating to the person

- a. Official name;
- b. first names;
- c. date of birth;
- d. sex;
- e. place of origin;
- f. place of birth;
- g. nationality;
- h. facial image;
- i. AHV number.

Additional data

- a. e-ID number;
- b. date of issue;
- c. expiration date;
- d. details of the ID used in the issuing process, in particular the type and expiration date of the ID;
- e. details of the issuing process.
